RFP for Operation and Maintenance of the Nuclear Medicine Facility in Newtown, Kolkata on PPP Mode

Subject: Corrigendum incorporating clarifications/amendments arising out of the Pre-Bid Queries and revision of Bid Due Date.

Reference: RFP Notice No. 001/2026 and the Response to Pre-Bid Queries issued by CNCI.

1. In continuation of the RFP issued for Operation and Maintenance of the Nuclear Medicine Facility in Newtown, Kolkata on PPP Mode, and pursuant to the clarifications/amendments communicated by CNCI in response to the Pre-Bid Queries, the following information/amendments shall be read as part of the RFP and the Draft Concession Agreement, wherever applicable.

A. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

1	Patient/Service Statistics for 2025–26	Total New Cancer Patient Registrations: 14,682; Total OPD Consultations (New + Follow-up): 1,23,283; Total IPD Admissions (New Town + Hazra): 23,222; Total Annual Surgeries: 2,032; Completed Radiation Therapy Cases: 3,286; Day Care Chemotherapy: 17,397.
2	PET-CT Equipment Details	Model: GE Discovery MI Digital Ready PET-CT System; Make: M/s GE Healthcare, USA. The equipment is presently covered under the initial five-year warranty. Approximate annual CMC cost: ₹60 lakh. The Authority shall continue to renew the CMC; however, the entire CMC cost shall be borne by the Concessionaire and paid to the Authority in accordance with the Concession Agreement.
3	Anticipated PET-CT Demand	The Authority anticipates sustained demand of approximately 25–30 PET-CT scans per day based on existing patient demand and waiting periods. This information is for reference only and shall not be construed as a minimum patient volume commitment or guarantee by the Authority.

B. AMENDMENTS / CLARIFICATIONS

Sl. No.	RFP / Subject	Amendment / Clarification
1	Performance Security – Clause 9.1.1	The Performance Security shall be ₹1.70 Crore (Rupees One Crore Seventy Lakh only), with minimum validity of 12 months at a time, in the prescribed form.
2	Schedule D – Human Resources	The minimum manpower per day shall be read as: RSO Level-II – 1; Nuclear Medicine Physician/Specialist – 1; Nuclear Medicine Technologist – 2; Staff Nurses – 4; Patient Care Attendants – 2; Receptionist & Data Entry Operator – 2. The Concessionaire shall ensure compliance with prevailing AERB regulations, statutory requirements and applicable standards throughout the Concession Period. The manpower requirement is intended for the complete spectrum of Nuclear Medicine Services including PET-CT, Gamma Camera and Iodine Therapy services.
3	Schedule M – Base Tariff	For Non-Chargeable Patients, the Base Tariff for the specified services shall be read as: GA-68 / FDG PET-CT Scan – ₹6,000 per scan; Whole Body Bone Scan with SPECT – ₹2,500 per scan.
4	Radiopharmaceutical Supply – Clauses 18.5 & 18.7 / Article 21	The Concessionaire shall, at its own cost and responsibility, procure all radiopharmaceuticals required for rendering Nuclear Medicine Services from AERB-approved/authorised suppliers and ensure uninterrupted availability. The Authority shall collect FDG charges of ₹3,000 per scan and Ga-68 charges of ₹7,000 per scan from Non-Chargeable and General Patients and reimburse the Concessionaire accordingly. For Market Patients, the Concessionaire shall collect and retain the aforesaid radiopharmaceutical charges. Service disruption due to non-availability shall not exceed one day in a calendar month; for disruption attributable to the Concessionaire beyond this period, penalty of ₹15,000 per affected patient shall apply and the affected scan/service shall be rescheduled within seven days.
5	Gamma Camera – Installation	The Authority shall procure and install the Gamma Camera within 9 months from the date of signing of the Concession Agreement. The concession obligations and KPIs for the Gamma service line shall apply upon handover of the Gamma Camera.
6	Minimum Guaranteed Patient Volume	No minimum patient volume shall be guaranteed by the Authority. The anticipated demand of approximately 25–30 PET-CT scans per day is indicative only and shall not constitute a commitment or guarantee.
7	Tariff Revision	The Base Tariff applicable under the Concession Agreement shall be subject to revision once every two years during the Concession Period. Any such revision shall be determined

		by the Authority and shall be within a range of 3% to 5% over the prevailing Base Tariff. The revised tariff shall be notified prior to commencement of the applicable revision period.
8	Eligibility – Clause 3.2.2 II.(b)	The Bidder (in case of a Single Entity) or any Member in case of a Consortium shall have been engaged in at least one radiology project with experience of operating CT Scan/MRI/PET Scan machines for any Government entity, Public Sector Undertaking, private hospital or private diagnostic centre in the last ten years preceding the Bid Due Date, subject to submission of satisfactory documentary evidence. Experience in both public and private sectors shall be considered.
9	Technical Capacity – 5,000 scans	The existing criterion shall be retained: The Bidder should demonstrate experience of operating at least one PET CT/MRI/CT scan machine with 5,000 scans annually for at least two years preceding the Bid Due Date. Participation through a Consortium is permitted and eligible experience may be demonstrated by the Consortium as per the RFP requirements.
10	Financial Capacity	The minimum average Annual Turnover (Financial Capacity) shall remain ₹17 Crore (Rupees Seventeen Crore only) for the last three financial years immediately preceding the Bid Due Date. In case of a Consortium, the combined Technical Capacity and Financial Capacity of the eligible Members having and continuing to have at least 26% equity share each in the SPV shall satisfy the eligibility condition, subject to the RFP.
11	Financial Statements / Annual Reports	The Single Entity Bidder or the Lead Member of the Consortium, or any member of the Consortium, as applicable, shall attach copies of the balance sheets, financial statements and Annual Reports for the three years preceding the Bid Due Date, as specified/clarified in the RFP.
12	Major Equipment Replacement / Breakdown	Any costs relating to major breakdowns/replacement of PET-CT/Gamma Camera components, as covered by the RFP/DCA risk allocation, shall be borne by the Concessionaire.

4. Except to the extent expressly amended/clarified herein, all other terms and conditions of the RFP and Draft Concession Agreement shall remain unchanged.

5. This Corrigendum shall be uploaded on the Official Website of CNCI and shall be binding on all prospective Bidders.
